INSTRUCTIONS:

1. This Certification form is to be completed by the Chief of the volunteer fire company described above, listing all members of the fire company who have an incident response record of a minimum of twenty percent (20%) of the Fire Company's emergency response calls between January 1 and November 30 of the year listed on the top of Page 1 or can no longer serve as an active volunteer with the Fire Company due to injury sustained during a response to an emergency call and have provided the Chief with documentation from a licensed physician.
2. This Certification must be signed by the Chief in the presence of a notary public and the notary's signature and seal must appear in the spaces indicated above.
3. The completed, signed, and notarized Certification must be delivered to and received by the Lehigh County Fiscal Office, Lehigh County Government Center, Room 467, 17 South 7th Street, Allentown, PA 18101 no later than December 15.
4. Members that are certified by being identified on this Certification will need to submit his or her own application to the Lehigh County Fiscal Office in order to qualify for the Lehigh County real estate tax credit. That form is available online on Lehigh County's website at www.lehighcounty.org. That completed form must be provided to the Lehigh County Fiscal Office no later than December 15.
5. Lehigh County Ordinance No 2023-118, Section 10 provides that any person who knowingly provides or conspires to provide false information that is used to compile a service record report commits a misdemeanor of the first degree punishable by a fine of \$2,500.00.
