Lehigh-Northampton LINK to Aging and Disability Resources



The Lehigh County Office of Aging and Adult Services, Northampton County Area Agency on Aging, Lehigh Valley Center for Independent Living (CIL), and Lehigh and Northampton County Apprise are the core partners for the Lehigh-Northampton LINK.

This is a collaborative effort funded by the Pennsylvania Department of Aging (PDA) to provide information and link-ages to long-term service and supports for people over 60 and adults with disabilities.

Lehigh-Northampton LINK partners work together to help seniors and adults with disabilities get connected to the closest agency or service to help you sustain your independence. Information and assistance on services will be provided for both private pay and publicly funded individuals.

There is no charge for assistance provided by the Lehigh-Northampton Link to Aging and Disability Resources although some service agencies may charge fees.

How can LINK assist you?

- Evaluate services necessary to remain independent
- Make connections with organizations that provide needed services
- Assist with applications to determine funding eligibility
