WHAT SHOULD YOU BRING WITH YOU TO A VITA SITE?

- ***Social Security Cards** or a Social Security verification letter issued by the Social Security Administration for everyone that will be on the tax return
- ***Proof of identification** (driver's license or other photo ID)
- ***Accurate birth dates** for everyone on the tax return
- Wage and earnings statements: **Forms W2, W2G, 1099R**, etc. from all employers or retirement plans
- Interest and dividend statements: **Forms 1099INT and 1099DIV**
- A copy of **last year's tax returns**, if available
- **Bank routing numbers** and **account numbers** for direct deposits for up to three accounts
- Total paid for day care and the **day care provider's** name, address, and tax ID number
- **College tuition** expenses: **Form 1098T**
- If you own your own home : **Real Estate Taxes** whether or not you itemize, mortgage interest, charitable donations made, and medical expenses paid during the year
- **Work-related expenses** you paid for (uniforms, union dues and small tools); these are deductible from your Pennsylvania taxes even if you do not itemize on your federal taxes
- **New car** purchased after 2/16/09: bring sales tax info
- **First Time Home Buyer**: bring HUD Settlement Sheet
- **Energy Credits**: bring purchase info
