

What is Section 3?

Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Act of 1968 requires that economic opportunities generated by certain HUD financially assisted housing and community development programs shall, to the greatest extent feasible, be given to low and very low-income persons, particularly those who are recipients of government assistance for housing, and to businesses that provide economic opportunities for these persons.

Who is responsible for Section 3 compliance?

Every community who receives financial assistance from HUD for Community Development projects and all of their contractors and subcontractors are responsible to offer any new training, employment or contracting opportunities to Section 3 or Section 3 businesses.

Who are Section 3 residents?

Public housing residents <u>including persons</u> with disabilities and low or very-low income persons who live in the area where a HUD assisted project is located.

The following income guidelines may be used to determine if you are a low to moderate income person/household living in Lehigh County where a HUD assisted project is located:

HOUSEHOLD SIZE	INCOME	HOUSEHOLD SIZE	INCOME
1 person	\$38,550 or below	5 person	\$59,500 or below
2 person	\$44,050 or below	6 person	\$63,900 or below
3 person	\$49,550 or below	7 person	\$68,300 or below
4 person	\$55,050 or below	8 person	\$72,700 or below

Eligibility for Preference

A section 3 resident seeking the preference in training and employment provided by this part shall certify, or submit evidence to the recipient contractor or subcontractor, if requested, that the person is a Section 3 resident, as defined in Section 135.5. (An example of evidence of eligibility for the preference is evidence of public housing residency, OR evidence that household income does not exceed the income guidelines, by family size, for low- or very low-income, as indicated elsewhere on this form.)
