ORDINANCE NO. 2015 -**

**APPROVING A REALLOCATED GREEN FUTURE FUND AWARD TO THE
CITY OF BETHLEHEM**

WHEREAS, the County of Lehigh has established a Green Future Fund Program under Resolution 2004-06; and

WHEREAS, various community municipalities have made requests of Lehigh County for funding from the Park Improvement and Recreation Reinvestment Grant initiatives; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, the Green Future Fund Committee and the Department of Community and Economic Development made recommendations to the Board of Commissioners regarding the organizations which should receive assistance, which recommendations were approved by Ordinance 2013-101; and

WHEREAS, the following recipient organization has requested a modification of their project due to changes in priorities; and

WHEREAS, the following organization would receive the same allocation as previously approved, however, the project for which the funds are to be used has been updated as follows:

Recipient	Previous Purpose	Approved by Ordinance No. 2013-101	New Purpose
City of Bethlehem	Restoration of Sand Island Lock #41	\$36,000.00	Northampton-Lehigh Footbridge (over Monocacy Creek)

WHEREAS, ordinance approval is required to reallocate funds for the previously approved grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF LEHIGH, PENNSYLVANIA, THAT:

1. The foregoing WHEREAS clauses are incorporated herein as if set forth in their entirety.

2. The project reallocation of the grant to the City of Bethlehem, as set forth herein, is hereby approved. Disbursal of the funds shall be contingent upon execution of grant agreement.

3. The proper officers and other personnel of Lehigh County are hereby authorized and empowered to take all such further action, including any necessary transfers of funds, and execute additional documents as they may deem appropriate to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

4. Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

5. This Ordinance shall become effective in ten (10) days after enactment.
