APPROVING A DONATION OF A VEHICLE TO THE SEED FARM

WHEREAS, the County of Lehigh ("County") is the owner of a 2005 Chevrolet K250 4x4 pickup truck, VIN# 1GCHK23U95F944312, which has been used by the Utility Bridges Garage; and

WHEREAS, because the vehicle is not suitable for driving long distances, the County has determined it no longer needs this vehicle and has replaced it with a better vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Department of General Services has worked with The Seed Farm and has determined that The Seed Farm is in need of such a vehicle for carrying crops and would be willing to accept the vehicle from the County; and

WHEREAS, Section 807 of the Administrative Code requires surplus county property to be sold at auction; and

WHEREAS, it would be advantageous to both parties for the County to donate this vehicle to The Seed Farm and not put it up for auction; and

WHEREAS, this donation requires ordinance approval as an exception to the procedure set forth in the Administrative Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY
THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF LEHIGH,

PENNSYLVANIA, THAT:

- 1. The foregoing Whereas clauses are incorporated herein as if set forth in their entirety.
- 2. The donation of the 2005 Chevrolet K250 4x4 pickup truck, VIN#

 1GCHK23U95F944312 to The Seed Farm, is hereby approved and the transfer is hereby exempt from the provisions of section 807 of the Administrative Code.
- 3. The proper officers and other personnel of Lehigh County are hereby authorized and empowered to take all such further action, including any necessary transfers of funds, and execute additional documents as they may deem appropriate to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
- 4. The County Executive shall distribute copies of this Ordinance to the proper officers and other personnel of Lehigh County whose further action is required to achieve the purpose of this Ordinance.
- 5. Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
 - 6. This Ordinance shall become effective in ten (10) days after enactment,
