We have recently completed an internal audit of payments made for the April 22, 2008 primary election. Our objective was to determine the primary election payments were properly made. Our audit included an examination of advances made to the Judges of Election and subsequent financial settlement made based on actual staffing at each polling place on election night. We also audited payments made for polling place rent, poll worker classes, election supply pick-up, and payments made to the members of the Board of Elections.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the "Standards for the Professional Practice of Internal Auditing", promulgated by the Institute of Internal Auditors. Our audit included examination of the accounting records, documentation, discussions with Office of Voter's Registration and Office of Fiscal Affairs personnel and other county personnel, and such other auditing procedures we considered necessary in the circumstances.

In our opinion, the attached schedule presents fairly, in all material respects, the amounts paid for the April 22, 2008 primary election.

We wish to thank the Office of Voter's Registration and the Office of Fiscal Affairs for their cooperation during the audit. This report is intended for the information and use of the Office of Voter's Registration and other affected county offices. However, this report is a matter of public record and its distribution is not limited.
