#### III. Provider Forum

## • Treatment Trends (Diana Heckman) (handout)

- Last year wrote a grant to PA Commission on Crime and Delinquency
  - ✓ Bring training to the Lehigh Valley over the next year and a half on all aspects of Trauma Informed Care
  - ✓ Audience for this training would be Drug and Alcohol and Mental Health Providers in Lehigh Valley
  - ✓ Approved and started the project in January and will run until September 2015
  - ✓ Offering three distinct periods of training. First training will begin in the Spring 2014 and will offer three courses. Different trainings will be offered in Fall 2014 as well as in Spring 2015.
  - ✓ Courses are free of charge
  - ✓ May 1<sup>st</sup> (currently full) training in Trauma Informed Criminal Justice Responses Robert Csandl and Jennifer Lopez will be the facilitators
  - ✓ May 8<sup>th</sup> Creating Cultures of Trauma Informed Care Introduction to a process on how an agency / organization can really look at the people they serve, the staff that serves them and how their agency is set up from the minute a client / consumer would call or come in to when they receive services to when they leave. Meant to be a self examination on the agency / organization as to what source of things they might change to look at client / consumer staff safety, empowerment and other aspects of the planning. There will be a two day training in the Fall to help assist with the self examination.
  - ✓ Third course will be offered this Spring Ability for Organizations to Deliver Seeking Safety. One of the best evidenced based well research modalities for mental health and drug and alcohol to use with consumers / clients.
  - ✓ Other trainings that will be offered are: TREM Trauma Recovery Empowerment Model; Something specifically for children who have been impacted by complex trauma.
  - ✓ All trainings will be held at 24 S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Allentown, PA (administrative offices of Treatment Trends)
- o Currently in the zoning hearing process to move the halfway home on 8<sup>th</sup> Street to what once was the Veterans Sanctuary on 24 S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Decision will be made at the hearing on Monday night.

## Haven House/The Neighborhood Health Centers of the Lehigh Valley (Allison Lech) (handout)

- NHCLV / Haven House collaborated to develop a BH/PH integrated program
  - ✓ Program went live on February 26, 2014
  - ✓ NHCLV is a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) who will treat anyone who walks in the front door and do not have insurance for physical health
  - ✓ Psychiatrist will be at NHCLV two Monday's a month
  - ✓ Interviewing for a part time Certified Peer Support
  - ✓ 20 clients to date (10 walk-in)
  - ✓ Location: 218 N. Second Street, Allentown, PA
  - ✓ Pertinent information will be shared if a release has been signed
