# • Healthy PA

- Governor Wolf is for the Medicaid expansion but not necessarily Healthy PA. If he wants to change the program it will need to go through a transition process because everything is ready to go for Healthy PA.
- o One letter stipulated if you are not a registered individual (recognized immigrant) you will not be served
- o Rolling out January 1, 2015
- Many pieces still have not been finalized and have been a challenge for everyone to get a clear sense of what it will all mean come January
- Types of Coverage: Private Coverage Option, Healthy Option (low risk individuals), Healthy Plus Option (high risk medically frail)
- ${\rm o}$  There may be benefit limits within the Healthy Option
- Everything continues to change

**Answer**: It is very important for providers to have their own policies and procedures regarding internal audits in order to prevent retractions. Patty will bring this back to the Compliance team to look at in 2015.

 Supplemental Services Application – moving forward the updated version must be used. Do not submit using the old application. Make sure you are using the application that has 9/24/2014 in gray diagonal on the page. Five months is not outside the norm to wait to have the application approved.

#### • Rebecca Mutchler

- o Magellan is doing an upgrade to their internal clinical system. It is called Total Member Record (TMR)
  - ✓ TMR pulls all data for a member onto the front screen which will help the customer service associates when they receive calls
  - ✓ Staff is currently being trained on this system
  - ✓ Will be launch first week in December

• State rolled out a white paper related to members with mental health and IDD diagnosis – specific recommendations for all MCO. Enhancements Magellan are implementing:

- ✓ Updating clinical policies around training and red flag clinically when a should be taken to a doctor
- ✓ Adding trainings annually each year
- ✓ Additional Care Manager will be hired and will focus on MH/IDD diagnosis only
- ✓ Adding a new service with NHS Human Services Dual Diagnosis Treatment Team (DDTT) community based program specific to members with MHID. This will be similar to the ACT model going out into the community and working with members.
- ✓ Goal is to work with member and family/group home staff to give them skills to de-escalate the member in order to keep the member in the community and out of the 24 hour level of care.
- ✓ Rollout: April 2015

  - ✓ Expanded to Broughel Middle School, Freedom High School (serves that High School, East Hills Middle School, the Vo-tech all on the same campus and 5 elementary schools in the area)

  - ✓ Working with NHCLV
  - ✓ More to come as it unfolds
