





The CARE Act

- The CARE Act provides your loved one the opportunity to designate a caregiver. (Designation)
- The CARE Act ensures that hospitals include the caregiver in discharge planning & provides necessary training for your loved one's care once they go home. (Notification)
- Inform you when your loved one is to be discharged to another facility or back home.





The CARE Act

- Allows hospitals to consult with the caregiver on the discharge plan, taking into account the caregiver's capabilities & limitations. (Consultation)
- Include Discharge plan includes contact information for necessary health & community resources in the discharge plan.
- Requires the hospital to give the caregiver the opportunity to receive instruction on all after-care tasks included in the discharge plan. (Training)
- Allows the caregiver the opportunity to ask questions.
