



The everyday LIFE program provides services to seniors as prevention of and an alternative to nursing home care. The program offers comprehensive healthcare services by a physician specializing in senior care, nurses, therapists, social workers, recreational therapy staff and personal care aides to meet the medical, social and emotional needs of participants. Services are provided in the participant's home, as well as on-site at the day health center in Bethlehem.

The everyday LIFE Day Health Center offers one convenient location where the member can go to receive preventive and restorative health care, meals, recreation and monitoring. The everyday LIFE Team works cooperatively with the member and his or her caregivers to formulate the optimal plan for maintaining the elder in the community for as long as possible.

To be eligible for Everyday LIFE, participants must:

- * be age 55 or older
- * live in Lehigh or Northampton counties
- * be able to live safely in the community with the assistance of Everyday LIFE services
- * meets the appropriate level of care requirements (as determined by the local Area Agency on Aging)
- * be determined eligible for Medical Assistance/Medicaid -In which there would be no out of pocket costs to the member (Monthly Gross Income under \$2094.00 and less than \$8000 in assets), or be able to pay privately-Approx \$4500 monthly for this all-inclusive care.
