- Expansion of drug and alcohol programs to ensure increased access to detox and rehab beds.
- Encouragement of providers to prescribe medication-assisted treatment (MAT), when appropriate.
- Proactive efforts with our county partners and the Commonwealth to promote the benefits of the Opioid Use Disorder Centers of Excellence and the Warm Hand-off Program.
