To be seen during walk in hours, you must bring:

\*\*\* Photo identification

\*\*\* Social Security Card (if you do not have your SS card, then please bring something else with your name and address listed on it.)

If you have **INCOME** and do not have services through medical assistance (which may include food stamps, OB/GYN coverage, etc.) you must also bring:

## Proof of income:

- \*\*\* Current paystub from employer
- \*\*\* SSD/SSI letter for the current year or copy of bank statement
- \*\*\* Unemployment compensation statement
- \*\*\* Interest or dividends from banking accounts

If your net income is over \$13,300, you must also bring:

- \*\*\* Doctor/Hospital Bills that are paid or unpaid from within the last year
- \*\*\* Pharmacy print out of prescriptions paid for the past year
- \*\*\* Child support, alimony
- \*\*\* Real Estate tax statement
