Parking Attendants—assist with directing visitor and volunteer parking.

Runners—Help out throughout the whole festival, assist with the efforts of all the volunteer stations and lend a hand where needed, help keep the grounds of historic Burnside Plantation looking clean and beautiful throughout the festival.

Beverage and Food—Serve blueberry based food and drinks to visitor, the most popular part of the festival.

Family Tours and Activities—Share the fun of colonial games and assist with crafts, tours of the plantation, and other great family oriented activities.
