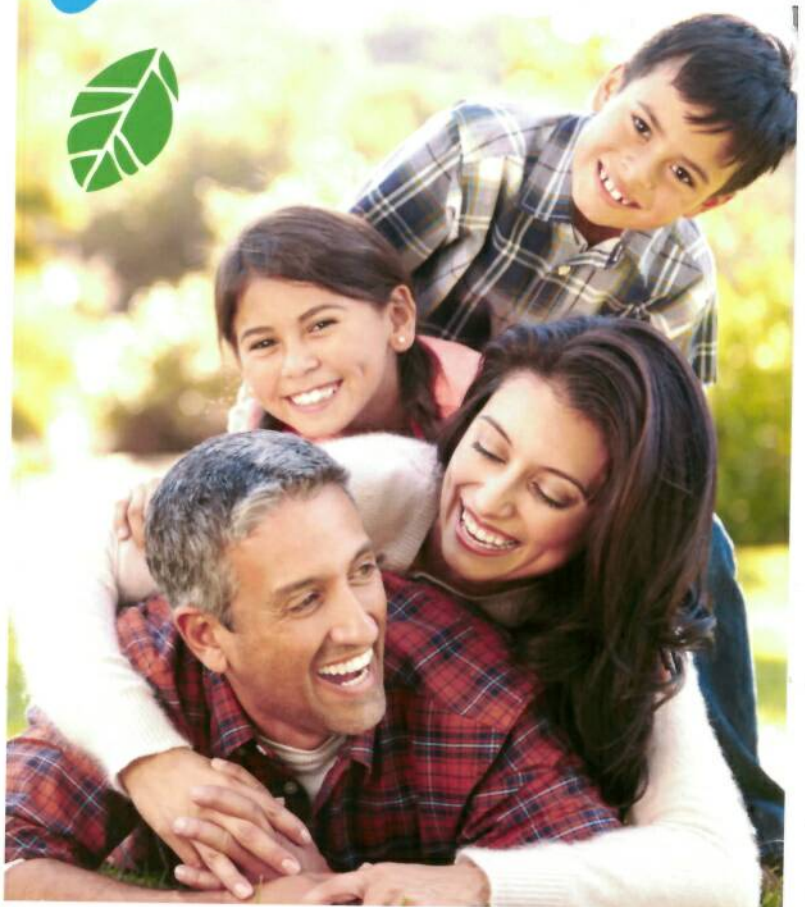

What is High Fidelity Wraparound?

- An evidence-based practice driven by the National Wraparound Initiative (NWI)
- Team-based, collaborative process for helping children and youth with special mental health needs and their families identify and use their strengths and community resources
- Develop and implement individualized Plans of Care to reduce the use of other restrictive mental health services
- Evidence-based model has been utilized internationally and adopted widely throughout the U.S.

Eligibility Criteria for Referred Youth

- Must be a resident of Lehigh County
- Must be between ages of 8 & 21 years
- Must have mental health diagnosis of serious emotional disturbance, excluding a principal diagnosis on the autism spectrum
- Must be eligible or actively enrolled in a medical assistance plan

Phases of High Fidelity Wraparound (HFW)

1. **Engagement and Team Preparation** - Lay groundwork for trust and shared vision, set tone for teamwork consistent with the principles
2. **Initial Plan Development** - Develop team cohesion and shared responsibility toward achievement of overarching goals of the individualized plan
3. **Implementation** - Implement the Plan of Care, progress/success continually reviewed; changes made as indicated. Repeat process until goals achieved and HFW no longer needed
4. **Transition** - Purposeful transition from HFW to appropriate formal/natural supports in the community and the adult system, if applicable

High Fidelity Team:

Facilitators collaborate with professional supports to ensure integrated planning occurs for youth and families.

Family Support Partners guide families through the process by sharing their parenting experience and encourage families to build their support system as well as increase their self-efficacy.

Youth Support Partners guide youth through the process by sharing their own experience, ensuring the youth’s voice is heard and supporting youth to develop a team of natural and professional supports.

Coaches ensure the High Fidelity Wraparound process is implemented with fidelity by providing group and individual coaching to the High Fidelity Wraparound team.

Supervisor oversees all aspects of the High Fidelity Wraparound Department.
