To be seen during walk in hours, you must bring: *** Photo identification *** Social Security Card (if you do not have your SS card, then please bring something else with your name and address listed on it.)

If you have **INCOME** and do not have services through medical assistance (which may include food stamps, OB/GYN coverage, etc.) you must also bring:

Proof of income:

*** Current paystub from employer

*** SSD/SSI letter for the current year – or copy of bank statement

*** Unemployment compensation statement

*** Interest or dividends from banking accounts

If your net income is over \$13,150, you must also bring:

*** Doctor/Hospital Bills that are paid or unpaid from within the last year

*** Pharmacy print out of prescriptions paid for the past year

*** Child support, alimony

*** Real Estate tax statement
