To be seen during walk in hours, you must bring:

\*\*\* Photo identification

\*\*\* Social Security Card (if you do not have your SS card, then please bring something else with your name and address listed on it.)

If you have **INCOME** and do not have services through medical assistance (which may include food stamps, OB/GYN coverage, etc.) you must also bring:

Proof of income:

\*\*\* Current paystub from employer

\*\*\* SSD/SSI letter for the current year – or copy of bank statement

\*\*\* Unemployment compensation statement

\*\*\* Interest or dividends from banking accounts

If your net income is over \$13,200, you must also bring:

\*\*\* Doctor/Hospital Bills that are paid or unpaid from within the last year

\*\*\* Pharmacy print out of prescriptions paid for the past year

\*\*\* Child support, alimony

\*\*\* Real Estate tax statement
